McKay scholarship updates:

McKay scholarship are kids with learning disabilities or severe disabilities. Students will receive scholarship. 40% of our student body is eligible for McKay scholarships. Connection with Wavecrest partnership helped to facilitate the McKay process and might also help parents interested in receiving McKay.

Meeting requirements attached to the scholarship program. Taking funding from the state means accepting some rules set by the state. State defines what exactly the meaning of instruction time is: Instruction that happens within the walls of a school. Outside instruction is not considered instructional time. Initially school was denied (80% did not meet their definition of instruction). Nevertheless, the school persisted, and the hours and attendance match and instruction part has been approved. Currently Verdi Eco school only needs to pass the school inspection, fire, code etc. All plans are in to pass, architecture drawings are in the making, fire code should pass. What needs to be addressed: Floors can't chip, no dangerous apparatus (bolts, rust etc.), mulch must be on the floor outside etc. Doors between kitchen and nature

immersion need to be removed. Windows must to be able to open and close. Painting the walls.

Nature Immersion: very hard to find great staff. Educators are leaving for various reasons. Current educators: Sydney, Carmen, Selina and Mikael. The schedule creates part time openings and full time is preferred. Very involved position.

New spots might open up as kids move up into higher school.

Kindergarten - hybrid of nature immersion and upper school.

Registration questions by parents:

Last year, summer tuition wasn't accounted for and school was underfunded. 4 weeks of 8 weeks of summer is paid for, the rest can be purchased by week. Parents can choose the 4 weeks they would like to have and our parents will get first choice. This coming school year - same amount of time off. Right now parents paid till May 24th. If registered tuition starts June 2nd and covers the summer.

Included in the years tuition (June 4th 2018 - June 7th 2019) schedule = 6 weeks :2 weeks (elective = intensives e.g. music, art etc = 3rd party educators). 3 Electives are included additional need to be paid for.

Input for:

6 week intensives: Students, parents can have an input into project based learnings. 2 week electives: if input - must be 3rd party that can handle kids. They are leading it as our core educators are prepping and being own vacation during that time.

Specialists and Feedback:

More specialists have been invited to the upper school. Highly qualified but transient. There just here occasionally.

Consultants:

Gifted educator, curriculum designer and special educators pulled in to address students who need more support. Core educators do not have the gifted certifications.

Gifted kids: There is a formal test to determine if the kid is gifted. Those students that benefit from the gifted part are kids who move every quickly through different subjects and very quickly through academics.
